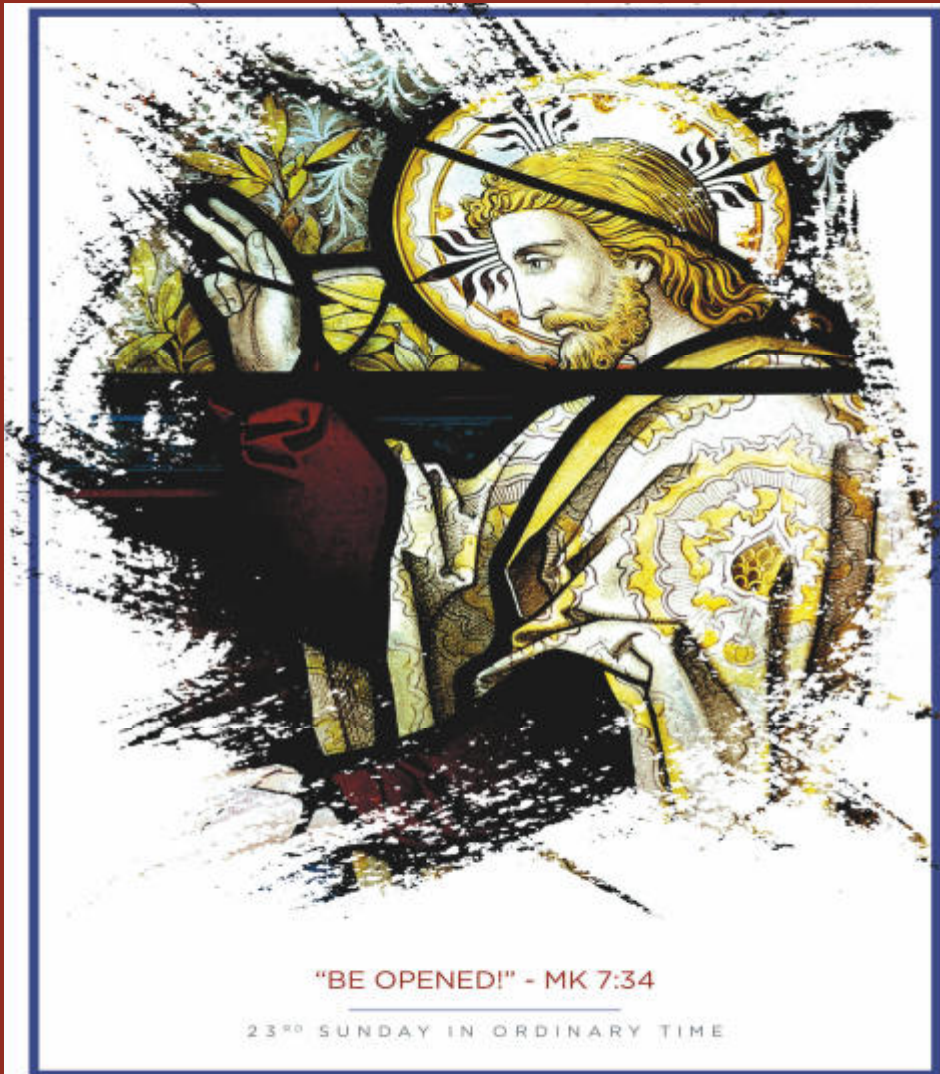

and he spoke plainly.

He ordered them not to tell anyone.

But the more he ordered them not to, the more they proclaimed it.

They were exceedingly astonished and they said, "He has done all things well.

He makes the deaf hear and the mute speak."

OUR PARISH SCHOOL

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a way of bringing children into a closer relationship with Christ through hands-on activities. We are in the process of having our atrium registered. The method for presenting it is simple: a passage is read from scripture, then the children ponder the meaning. After the Bible is read, the children interact with material to make it concrete. Children also practice nomenclature or naming items they would see during Mass and the other sacraments. The practical life component of the program is to prepare them to serve in the church as altar servers, sacristan, etc. Finally, children like adults can be drawn closer to God through the arts. Students will create maps, diagrams and other prayer reflecting creations. This Montessori approach feels like a mini retreat each week and the children have been very excited to visit the atrium in the East Hall of our school.



FAITH FORMATION

Adult Confirmation Program

"Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit."

The Adult Confirmation process is a wonderful interactive opportunity for Catholics who have not had the opportunity to receive the sacrament of Confirmation to complete their full initiation into the Catholic Church. Registration is now open. Classes are weekly on Sunday mornings and begin in October. The Confirmation celebration takes place annually and is arranged in accordance with the Bishop's calendar.

Requirements for Adult Confirmation Preparation

Candidates for this Sacrament should:

- Be a registered parishioner.
- Be a baptized Catholic providing a current baptismal certificate within the last 6 months.
- Have made their First Communion.
- If married, must have been married in the Catholic Church.
- Attend Sunday Mass on a regular basis.
- Have a Sponsor for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
